I. The Impact of His Faithfulness in Our Lives

The Lord is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him. Nahum 1:7

Faithfulness means "good faith, faithfulness, sincerity"; being faithful, sincere"; and "all good fidelity" The Hebrew word rendered "faithfulness" is *emunah*, which Strong's says literally means "firmness," figuratively means "security" and morally means "fidelity." Spiros Zodhiates

- A. God is faithful to His **people**. Deut. 7:9
- B. God is faithful to His promise. 1 Kings 8:56 Jeremiah 1:12
- C. God is faithful to His purpose and plan. Romans 8:28
- D. God is faithful to give His **provision**. Deut. 16:15
- E. God is faithful to give His **protection**. Psalm 91

II. Assurance - The Result of His Faithfulness

As we place our trust in the care of our Father, we experience an assurance that will be the bedrock of confidence for our lives in the midst of anything we face.

How established am I in my understanding of the assurance God wants me to experience? What can I do to become better established in all the assurances God has made to me?

Core Point: Seeing into the very heart of God reveals pure faithfulness. God is infinitely faithful and true. As we behold His character it emboldens our faith because we know He will never fail those who put their trust in Him!

III. Trusting In the Lord - The Answer to Everything

The secret lies in putting this truth into practice, by making it such a powerful theme in your life that you view everything you face with prayer to your God with the unshakable conviction that He is totally, spotlessly trustworthy!

Trust God from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for God's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; He's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Run to God! Run from evil! Your body will glow with health, your very bones will vibrate with life! Honor God with everything you own; give Him the first and the best. Your barns will burst, your wine vats will brim over. Prov. 3:5-11

Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. Psalm 37:3

Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God is a refuge for us. Selah Psalm 62:8

The refuge we have is **trusting in His faithfulness and living with the assurance that gives us!**

I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust." Psalm 91:2
