Thinking Right:

Proverbs 4:23 “Be careful how you think; your life is shaped by your thoughts.” GNT

Philippians 4:8 “And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.” NLT

2 Corinthians 10:5 “Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.” KJV

Psalms 104:34 “May all my thoughts be pleasing to Him, for I rejoice in the LORD.” NLT

Psalms 51:10 “Create in me a new, clean heart, O God, filled with clean thoughts and right desires.” TLB

Love:

John 15:12 “This is my commandment, that you love one another, as I have loved you.” KJV

1 John 3:1 “Behold, what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called the sons of God.” KJV

1 John 4:7,10 “Beloved, let us love on another: for love is of God: and every one that loves is born of God, and knows God.” KJV “This is love: not that we have loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the payment for our sins.” GW

1 Corinthians 8:3 But whoever loves God is known by God.” NIV

1 John 4:21 “Christ has given us this commandment: The person who loves God must also love other believers.” GW

John 13:34 “So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.” NLT

Fear & Anxiety

2 Timothy 1:7 “For God has not given us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.” AMPC

Matthew 6:25 “Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?” AMP

Heaven (Assured that you’re going):

Isaiah 41:10 “Don’t panic. I’m with you. There is no need to fear for I’m your God. I’ll give you strength. I’ll help you. I’ll hold you steady, keep a firm grip on you.” MSG

1 Corinthians 2:9 “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither entered into the heart of man, the things which God has prepared for them that love Him.” KJV

1 John 5:13 “I’ve written this letter to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you will be assured and know without a doubt that you have eternal life.” TPT

1 John 5:11-12 “This is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is found in His Son. The person who has the Son has life. The person who doesn’t have the Son doesn’t have life.” GW

John 14:1-3 “Don’t let your heart be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. There is more than enough room in my Father’s home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.” NLT

Mark 16:19 “When the Lord Jesus had finished talking with them, He was taken up into heaven and sat down in the place of honor at God’s right hand.” NLT

Hebrews 9:24 “For Christ did not go into a Holy Place made by human hands, which was a copy of the real one. He went into heaven itself, where He now appears on our behalf in the presence of God.” GNT

Healing:

Psalm 91:10-11 “No harm will come to you. No sickness will come near your house. He will put His angels in charge of you to protect you in all your ways.” GW

Romans 8:11 “Does the Spirit of the One who brought Jesus back to life live in you? Then the One who brought Christ back to life will also make your mortal bodies alive by His Spirit that lives in you.” GW

Isaiah 53:5 “But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.” KJV
